


Bike Routes - Abraham Lincoln Elementary School

Abraham Lincoln Elementary School is located on the Methow Street bicycle route. Other nearby marked bicycle routes are on Crawford and Okanogan Streets. Other streets nearby that may be of use for bicyclists include Cascade, Stevens, and Red Apple. None of these streets include bicycle lanes. Stevens Street between Malaga and Methow is narrow and has no sidewalks. A small portion of Methow just south of the school has no sidewalk. A city grant to correct this is pending. Students living directly south of campus are asked to exit the school on the Cascade side where connecting sidewalks are available. For most elementary-aged riders, bicycling on sidewalks will be the safest way to and from school.

The playground can also be reached by openings in the fence on Cascade Avenue at Red Apple and at Fairfield. Another entrance to the playground is at the intersection of Lincoln and Walker. Bicycle racks are located in front and in the back of the school. Crossing guards are available at the following times during the school year.

Tu.-Fri. 7:45 - 8:10 a.m.

Mon.-Fri. 2:45 - 3:00 p.m.
