Entries MUST BE RECEIVED by the American Legion Post 10 no later than May 1, 2016 in order to be judged locally before the District deadline of June $\mathbf{1}^{st}$ and the Department deadline of July $\mathbf{1}^{st}$. Winners will receive local recognition by Post 10 and be submitted to the American Legion District 9 for certification and presentation to the American Legion Department of Washington before July $\mathbf{1}^{st}$.
