The **Horticulture Program of Study** will teach students the basics of plant anatomy, reproduction, and management, as well as various fields of species identification. Students can focus on the planning, planting, growing, and final sale of decorative bedding plants and garden vegetables in a full-production greenhouse. Students also can learn the art and science of flower aesthetics and arrangement for various occasions in both personal and professional applications. Another option is to learn skills related to the identification, evaluation, management, and utilization of local and regional forest tree species and products.
