

Holidays

The district will observe the following school holidays and will not operate on these days:

1. Sunday;
2. New Years' Day (January 1) ;
3. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (third Monday in January) ;
4. President's Day (third Monday in February);
5. Memorial Day (last Monday in May);
6. Juneteenth (June 19)
7. Independence Day (July 4);
8. Labor Day (first Monday in September);
9. Veteran's Day (November 11);
10. Thanksgiving Day (fourth Thursday in November);
11. The day after Thanksgiving (Native American Heritage Day); and
12. Christmas Day (December 25).

Whenever any legal holiday, other than a Sunday, falls on Sunday, the following Monday will be a legal holiday, and whenever any legal holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday will be a legal holiday.

In addition to the above, the following shall also be considered to be holidays: the day before Christmas, the day before New Year's Day (December 24, December 31).
