

School Instrument Loan Agreement

The Wenatchee School District has a very limited number of instruments for use by students because of the unique nature of the instrument or for those who are unable to rent. Demand is always high for these instruments and those who choose to use a school instrument will sometimes even have to share with another student. There is no fee for the use of these instruments, but there are a number of responsibilities attached to this privilege:

1. Instruments MUST ALWAYS be at the scheduled lesson so your student's partner[s] can have their turn with the instrument. If your child will miss school on a rehearsal day, it is YOUR responsibility to get the instrument to school in time for class. Failure to do so will result in loss of "take-home privileges".
2. Participants in the school instrument loan program MUST maintain adequate and consistent practice when they have the instrument at home. The District has too few instruments to loan them to students who don't practice.
3. Parents have the responsibility to make certain the instrument is not lost, stolen, abused, defaced or mistreated in any way. Routine repairs due to normal use will be the responsibility of the District. The cost for repairs of damage due to carelessness or purposeful abuse will be charged to the parents.

We have read and understand the above stated conditions and responsibilities attached to the use of a school instrument during the current school year at no charge. We agree to make sure the instrument is available for each scheduled lesson; that our child will practice regularly; and that the instrument will be handled with care.
