Wenatchee School District uses automated telephone calls, emails and text messages to share emergency and education-related information with our families. The messages that you receive from the District are not for marketing, commercial or political purposes. By providing your contact information, you consent to receive automated messages. You also agree to provide the District with updated contact information when any of the information changes. The District is not responsible for any text message or phone charges incurred. Check with your phone provider as rates may apply.

Message Types:

Emergency

Health and safety of students and faculty, weather closures, and incidents of threats or imminent danger to the school.

Education-Related

School and District notifications, unexcused absences, event reminders, low lunch balances and parent teacher organization invitations and fundraiser notices.
