Students who complete 2 credits in this pathway will meet their state graduation pathway through the CTE Sequence option.

The **Athletic Training and Recovery Program of Study** includes courses that provide students with an exploration into medical careers, medical language, anatomy/physiology, and medical evaluation/treatment/rehabilitation skills. Students will conduct hands-on projects and activities that prepare them for healthcare careers. While learning specific healthcare skills such as taping, wrapping, and evaluative techniques, students will also learn how to solve problems, analyze data, and work within a healthcare team to support physical and mental health.
