Air Force JROTC Program

In the **Air Force Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) Program of Study** students will learn about applied flight sciences, military aerospace policies, space exploration, and Air Force heritage and traditions. These courses provide opportunities to develop leadership skills. Students learn about aerospace science, leadership education, and physical fitness. To reinforce what is learned in the classroom, there are many outside activities such as field trips to military bases, aerospace facilities, museums, and other areas related to aerospace education. Students may participate in parades, summer leadership, and drill competitions.

- Student attends 2 years of JROTC and enters the military can graduate basic training as an E-2
- Student attends 3 years of JROTC and enters the military and graduates basic training as an E-3.
