The **Production Art Program of Study** teaches the Elements of Art and Principles of Design. Students engage in creating 3-dimensional, 2-dimensional, and Digital works of art. The program includes opportunities to learn the fundamentals of drawing, painting, sculpture, ceramics, photography, and animation. Students will be introduced to industry-related career paths within our community and will learn how to link their creative initiatives to the workforce. Students will learn to create with many different mediums of art, present to their peers and the community, respond to other artists' work through critique, and make connections through professional-level artist statements.
