Attendance Changes: Positive Attendance

In order to maximize instructional time, encourage student responsibility, and improve student safety, Wenatchee High School has implemented a new system for classroom attendance. Rather than being marked as absent by the teacher, students will be required to scan into class using the barcode on their student ID card. When students scan in, they will be marked present by the Skyward system. This is very similar to a timecard system at a place of employment. Every classroom space will have a scanner available to record attendance. If a student does not scan into class, they will be marked as absent by Skyward. **All students must have their school ID with them to scan into each class on a daily basis**.

Attendance

When a student is absent, the parent or guardian needs to verify the reason for the absence using one of the following methods within 48 hours of returning to school.

- 1. Send a signed note to the attendance office with the dates of absence(s) and reason.
- 2. Email the attendance office with the dates of absence(s) and reason. Email: whsattendance@wenatcheeschools.org
- 3. Call the attendance office to speak with an attendance secretary at 663-6903.

**Reminder: Absences that have already occurred cannot be excused by voicemail.

Parents and Guardians Please Sign Up to Receive Our Text Messages

Wenatchee HS will begin utilizing the school messenger system to deliver text messages. Text messages will be delivered straight to your mobile phone with important information about attendance, events, school closings, safety alerts and more.*

Also, the school messenger app will allow you to choose how you receive information we send. You can choose to receive information in any combination of text, phone call, or email.

Skyward Family Access!

Parents and guardians are encouraged to sign up for Skyward Family Access. This will give you online access to view your child's grades, attendance information and more!

- You will receive important communications quicker.
- Links to teacher email addresses allow for easy communication with your child's teachers.
- The attendance calendar provides the ability to view any excused or unexcused absences in detail.
- View your student's assignments and report cards.
- Know where your child is during the day by viewing their schedule.
- Verify all email addresses.
- Verify that the information we have on file for your student is accurate.

Online Tutoring and Homework Help:

Wenatchee High School has partnered with an online tutoring service to provide students with another opportunity for 1-on-1 homework help. This service allows students to work with a tutor at any time during the day or night (24/7). The service provides support for over 40 subject areas including all AP courses, and you will find that Spanish speaking tutors are available in math, science and social studies.

When students login to the service, the amount of time they work with a tutor is deducted from the total hours that we have purchased. The time deducted is the same regardless of the subject area students choose, or the time of day students are accessing the service. So, we ask that the time is used wisely.

The service may be used on a computer, tablet or smartphone and all correspondence is recorded within their system for the purpose of student safety.
