Students are encouraged to purchase an ASB Sticker for \$30. This will grant you admission to all *home* Panther sporting events for FREE and will also offer discounts on most dance admissions.

If you are planning on participating in any sport, club, or activity this year, you MUST purchase an ASB Sticker. All money raised from the sale of ASB Stickers is allocated to activities and athletics to help support those groups.

You can purchase your sticker in the ASB Office after you have obtained your Student ID Card.

All students are required to have their photo taken for identification purposes.

WHS students/parents now have the convenience of paying school fines and fees online. Simply visit the website listed above and log in.

Username is the student's ID number preceded by a 0.

Password is the student's last name in capital letters.

Any payments made will automatically show up in the student receipt system used by the ASB Office. You may also print your receipt when the purchase is finalized. (Please note there is a 3% transaction fee for the use of this service.)

DIRECTED STUDY

Wenatchee High School will continue to offer Directed Study as a course option for students. The Directed Study Project Guide will be given to each student, and the requirements of the program will be explained after school starts. In the meantime, if you have any questions please contact your student's counselor by calling 509-663-8117.

PE UNIFORMS

A PE Uniform is required for all students enrolled in a PE class at WHS. Uniforms will be distributed the first week of school during class.

The uniforms are \$13. Students can pay for uniform prior to school starting or will receive a fee on their account. (If paying fees by check, a separate check is required for PE items. Debit/Credit cards are also accepted. The uniforms come in sizes from S-XXXL. Both shorts and shirts have a space for the student's name to be written in permanent ink. If desired, students may wear uniforms worn during middle school.

SCHOOL PICTURES AND ID CARDS

School Pictures will be Monday, August 26th. All students, including seniors, are required to have their picture taken for student ID cards. (There is no charge for the ID card.) Please note the times listed below for pictures:

Please follow the planned schedule! This will keep us moving smoothly. Remember, this picture will serve as your ID picture as well as your yearbook picture. You can also purchase a variety of packages so come prepared. Dress code will be enforced. For multiple student households, additional photo package order forms are available at the school or online at parsonsphotography.com. Picture retake day is scheduled for September 23rd.

Students whom have band or sport practice can come in from 7:45am-9:15am.

DANCE RULES

All school rules shall be enforced at school dances. Please pay particular attention to the following items:

- School dress code will be enforced at dances.
- Appropriate dancing only-no grinding, etc. Face-to-Face with a little space.
- Avoid any appearance of public displays of affection, aka PDA.

Any violation of any of the Dance Rules stated above will result in students being removed from the dance .

STUDENT ID CARD/OPEN CAMPUS POLICY

All students must have their school ID with them to scan into each class on a daily basis for attendance purposes. In order to participate in Open Campus at lunch, students must:

- 1. Be a Junior or Senior.
- 2. Have 12 or fewer total periods marked as "unexcused" and/or "tardy/late" during the previous quarter.
- 3. Have ID card with OPEN CAMPUS sticker visible when exiting the building.
- 4. Enter the building at the main entrance when returning. Be sure to have your ID with sticker visible when entering.

**Parents may revoke open campus privilege at any time by contacting one of the Assistant Principals.

CLASS SCHEDULES & CORRECTIONS

The Wenatchee High School counseling staff works extremely hard to ensure that all of our students receive the classes that they requested in addition to their required classes. Even so, some errors do occur. If you have an error in your schedule due to one of the reasons listed below, counselors will correct your schedule. Students can check their schedules through their student SKYWARD account. (See Skyward Login assistance on page 8) **Freshmen will be given their SKYWARD login information, along with their class schedule on Picture Day, August 26th, but may also log in to Skyward at any time to view their schedule. Use the "forgot login/password" link and follow instructions listed on page 8, starting at step 4.**

- 1. Students who do not have a complete schedule or have two classes scheduled in the same period.
- 2. A required course was not scheduled.
- 3. You were incorrectly placed in a course for which you do not have the appropriate skill level or do not have the prerequisite class.
- 4. You have already taken and passed the class for which you are scheduled.
- 5. You failed a class in the past and received the same teacher for the same class on your new schedule.
- 6. You need to adjust your schedule because of Running Start or Skills Center conflicts.

Starting on **Wednesday**, **August 14th**, students can access and submit Schedule Change Request Forms in the Counseling Office. A list of available classes will be posted each morning outside the Counseling Office and on the Counseling web page to help facilitate the process. Students are only allowed to submit forms once, so please refer to the list of available classes first and be detailed with your requests. Once you submit your form to the Counseling Office, check your Skyward account to see if the requested changes were possible.

Forms will be accepted through **Monday**, **August 26th at 3:00pm**. Priority will be give to changes necessary for graduation or due to error. Only necessary changes will be made after the start of the school year.



POSITIVE ATTENDANCE

In order to maximize instructional time, encourage student responsibility, and improve student safety, Wenatchee High School will continue to use the Positive Attendance System to track classroom attendance. Rather than being marked as absent by the teacher, students will be required to scan into class using the bar code on their Student ID card. When students scan in, they will be marked "present" by the Skyward system. This is very similar to a time card system at a place of employment. Every classroom space will have a scanner available to record attendance. If a student does not scan into class, they will be marked as absent by Skyward. ALL STUDENTS MUST HAVE THEIR SCHOOL ID WITH THEM TO SCAN INTO EACH CLASS ON A DAILY BASIS.

ATTENDANCE

When a student is absent, the parent or guardian needs to verify the reason for the absence using one of the following methods within 48 hours of returning to school.

- Send a signed note to the Attendance Office with the date(s) and reason.
- E-mail the Attendance Office with the date(s) of absence(s) and reason. E-mail: whsattendance@wenatcheeschools.org
- Call the Attendance Office to speak with an Attendance Secretary at 509-663-8117.

**Reminder: Absences that have already occurred cannot be excused by voicemail.

SCHOOL MEALS

Students will have *two opportunities* to eat breakfast this year at WHS:

- Served daily in the cafeteria
 30 minutes prior to the passing period before first period
- Grab & Go* breakfast during the passing period between first and second period.

*Stations will be set up in the hallways to offer easy access to students as they travel from one class to another.

Please note, if a student receives reduced or free meals, ONLY the first breakfast purchased will be given at no charge. If a student chooses to eat BOTH breakfast options, he or she *must pay full price* (**\$1.65**) for the second breakfast.

SKYWARD LOGIN ASSISTANCE

To Log in:

- 1. Go to: wenatcheeschools.org/whs
- 2. Click on the Students tab at the top of the screen. Then click on the Skyward link under "Quick Links."
- 3. Enter your Login ID and Password. Your login ID is the first 5 letters of your last name, then the first 3 letters of your first name, followed by 3 zeros. In the event of duplicate names, the three zeros would change to two zeros then the number one. (Example for Juan Reynosa: REYNOJUA000 or REYNOJUA001 if more than one student exists with that name.)
- 4. If you have forgotten your Login ID or Password information, click on the "Forgot your Login/Password?" Link.
- 5. Then enter your Wenatchee School District assigned e-mail address and click "Submit."
- 6. An e-mail with reset instructions will be sent.
- 7. If you are still unable to access your Skyward account, go to the main office for assistance.

*If you attempt to login into your account multiple times and are unable to get in, you will be locked out, so be sure to use the "Forgot your Login/Password?" link if you are unsuccessful after two attempts.
