	<p>Possibility of having students back for full days</p>	<p>No idea what the responses are s far. We are going to have students take their surveys during the school day, in class. Everyone at the same time. District leadership wants a high number of student responses.</p> <p>Will the survey fit the high school? The current parent survey doesn't seem to communicate the truth of our social distancing situation. The district seems to have done its best to provide a realistic picture.</p> <p>What are the results if a student has covid and comes to school? There are prescribed responses.</p> <p>What can we do to keep social distancing at the high school? We need to ask ourselves what we will need to do in order to social distance.</p> <p>Suddenly moving to 85 minute classes is a very large concern for many staff members.</p> <p>What about the workload of teachers who've changed all their planning to fit our shorter instruction time.</p> <p>Right now, how classes will look isn't defined. 85 minutes straight? Class time clocked differently? We live in a world of ideas and possibilities instead of rebar and concrete.</p> <p>Serious concerns over the behavior of motivational speaker Brian Cain in a previous coaching session from 2017. Is this really the kind of person we want speaking to our students? What does it say about us if continue to bring him back? How do we reconcile that choice with the culture we want here at WHS?</p> <p>Some teacher are getting new students or students are being pulled from their courses.
